I know that he went into the army; that he served honorably the confederate cause and that after the war he was honorably discharged from said service.

I know this of my own knowledge and there in no hearsay about it. I was there at the time. I know that he was a member of the 25th Regiment of Georgia.

He first went into the Georgia regiment and then was sent to a cavalry outfit from Alabama.
