





The army was surrendered by General Johnston to General Sherman April 26, and paroled at Greensboro.

A list of the officers and men of the Jasper Avengers organized at Garlandsville Jasper Co. Miss. on Saturday the 15th March 1862 carried the name of J. P. CURRY.


