The records show that Noah Harris. a private, Company D, 41st Mississippi Infantry, Confederate States Army, was enlisted March 3, 1862, at Macon, Mississippi, by Captain Koger. He is borne as present on the muster roll of the company for March and April, 1863, but does not appear on subsequent rolls to August, 1864, the last on file.

The records also show that one N. Harris, a private, Company B, 9th Battalion, Mississippi Sharpshooters, Confederate States Army, was enlisted at Macon, Mississippi, March 3, 1862, by Captain Koger. The prisoner of war records show him as Noah H. Harris, captured November 25, 1863, and received for exchange, at Boulware's Wharf, Virginia, March 5, 1865. No connection has been found in this of-fice between the two organizations mentioned above.
