Mr. Hoskins stated in his application for Confederate Pension that he was a private in Company H. 30th Texas Cavalry. Confederate States Army. He enlisted about 1862 and served until the close of the war in 1865. The exact date of enlistment and discharge is not given.

The application for pension of Mr. Moskins was approved on the affidavits of witnesses.
