The records show Pobert H. King, also borne as H. R. King, was a private in Company A. Sord Alabama Infantry, Confederate States Army. He enlisted February 22, 1862 and served until June 1, 1865.

The application for pension was approved on affidavits of witnesses and a report from the War Department, Washington, D. C.
